from london gatwick airport

by train

Gatwick Railway Station is located in the south terminal. Thames Trains run a service from the Airport to Oxford City Railway Station. Some trains are direct but most involve a change at Reading Station. The Journey will take approximately 2 hours 15 minutes.

The cost of a single ticket from Gatwick – Oxford is approximately £20

by coach

Gatwick's Coach Station is located on the ground floor of the South Terminal. 'The Airline' bus service runs from 01:00 – 23:15, offering a direct service to Oxford, Gloucester Green. The journey will take approximately 2 hours 30 minutes.

The cost of a single ticket from Gatwick – Oxford is approximately £25

Take the M23 and join the M25 Heathrow. Join M40 Oxford and leave at junction 9 (Oxford, Blenheim Palace, A34) Take the A34, Leave at Kidlington turn-off. Follow the road to the bottom and bear left at the roundabout. Turn right at the 1st set of traffic lights (next to Harvester restaurant and follow the road to the end. Turn right at the traffic lights and follow the road $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. Oxford Airport is signposted to your left.

A taxi from Gatwick to Oxford will cost you approximately £125

from london heathrow airport

by train

The Reading Air Bus Link runs from all Heathrow terminals on average every 20 minutes. The Air bus takes you to Reading Station and connects with the train into Oxford.

The cost of a single ticket from Heathrow – Oxford is approximately £20

by coach

Oxford's coach service named 'The Airline', runs from both Heathrow's terminal 4 & Central Bus Station every 30 minutes throughout the day and every 2 hours through the night. This service will bring you directly to Oxford's Central Bus Depot, Gloucester Green. The Journey will take approximately 1 hour 30 minutes.

The cost of a single ticket from Heathrow – Oxford is approximately £20.

Join the M25 Southbound. Join M40 Oxford and leave at Junction 9 (Oxford, Blenheim Palace, A34) Take the A34, Leave at Kidlington turn-off. Follow the road to the bottom and bear left at the roundabout. Turn right at the 1st set of traffic lights (next to Harvester restaurant and follow the road to the end. Turn right at the traffic lights and follow the road $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. Oxford Airport is signposted to your left.





from london luton airport

by train

Take the train Luton Airport Parkway to Farringdon Thameslink. You will then need to take the underground to Paddington Station, where you can catch a direct train to Oxford City Station. The total journey will take approximately 2 hours 30 minutes.

The cost of a single ticket from Luton Parkway – Oxford is approximately £30

There is currently some disruption on this line and we ask you to check with the operator before travel for up to date information.

by coach

The coach pick up point is situated in front of the terminal building. National Express, 'Jetlink', operate a direct service from Luton Airport to Oxford, Gloucester Green. However, some journeys may involve a change at either Hemel Hempstead or Heathrow. The journey will take approximately 2 hours 30 minutes.

The cost of a single ticket from National Express Luton – Oxford is approximately £15, However journeys that require a change at Hemel Hempstead are £10.

Follow signs for M1 as you leave the airport. Join M1 at junction 20 Southbound. Join M25 Heathrow. Join M40 Oxford and leave at Junction 9 (Oxford, Blenheim Palace, A34) Take the A34, Leave at Kidlington turn-off. Follow the road to the bottom and bear left at the roundabout. Turn right at the 1st set of traffic lights (next to Harvester restaurant and follow the road to the end. Turn right at the traffic lights and follow the road $\frac{3}{4}$ of a mile. Oxford Airport is signposted to your left.

from london stansted airport

by train

The airport railway station is situated below the terminal. Catch the 'Stansted Express' into Liverpool Street Station. Then take the underground to Paddington Station, where you can catch a direct train into Oxford City Station. The entire journey will take approximately 3 hours.

The cost of a single ticket from Stansted – Oxford is approximately £35.

There is a direct service between Stansted Airport and Oxford Gloucester Green. Catch the 'Jetlink 757' from the coach terminal. This service runs every 2 hours throughout the day and night. The journey will take approximately 3 ½ hours.

There is a direct train from Birmingham International Train Station to Oxford City. It departs at 13 minutes past the hour throughout the day & night. The journey takes approximately 1 hour.

Take the M40 London. This is signposted as you leave the airport. Leave at Junction 9 (Oxford, Blenheim Palace, A34) Take the A34, Leave at Kidlington turn-off. Follow the road to the bottom and bear left at the roundabout. Turn right at the 1st set of traffic lights (next to Harvester restaurant and follow the road to the end. Turn right at the traffic lights and follow the road ¾ of a mile. Oxford Airport is signposted to your left.



from oxford bus & train stations

by bus

Gloucester Green Bus Terminal is situated in the heart of Oxford City. You will need to walk out of the main entrance onto George Street. Turn left and there are bus stops about 3 minutes walk up the road. From this bus stop on Magdalen Street you can catch the 'Oxford Bus Company' service 2C, 2D or a 'stagecoach' 7D. The number 2 services will take you directly to Oxford Airport at peak times in the morning and evening, Monday to Friday. The 7D runs throughout the day including weekends and return tickets or passes issued by the Oxford Bus Company are accepted by the 7D during off-peak times, to and from the airport. The journey will take approximately 30 minutes and a single ticket will cost you £2.00 or a return ticket £3.00.

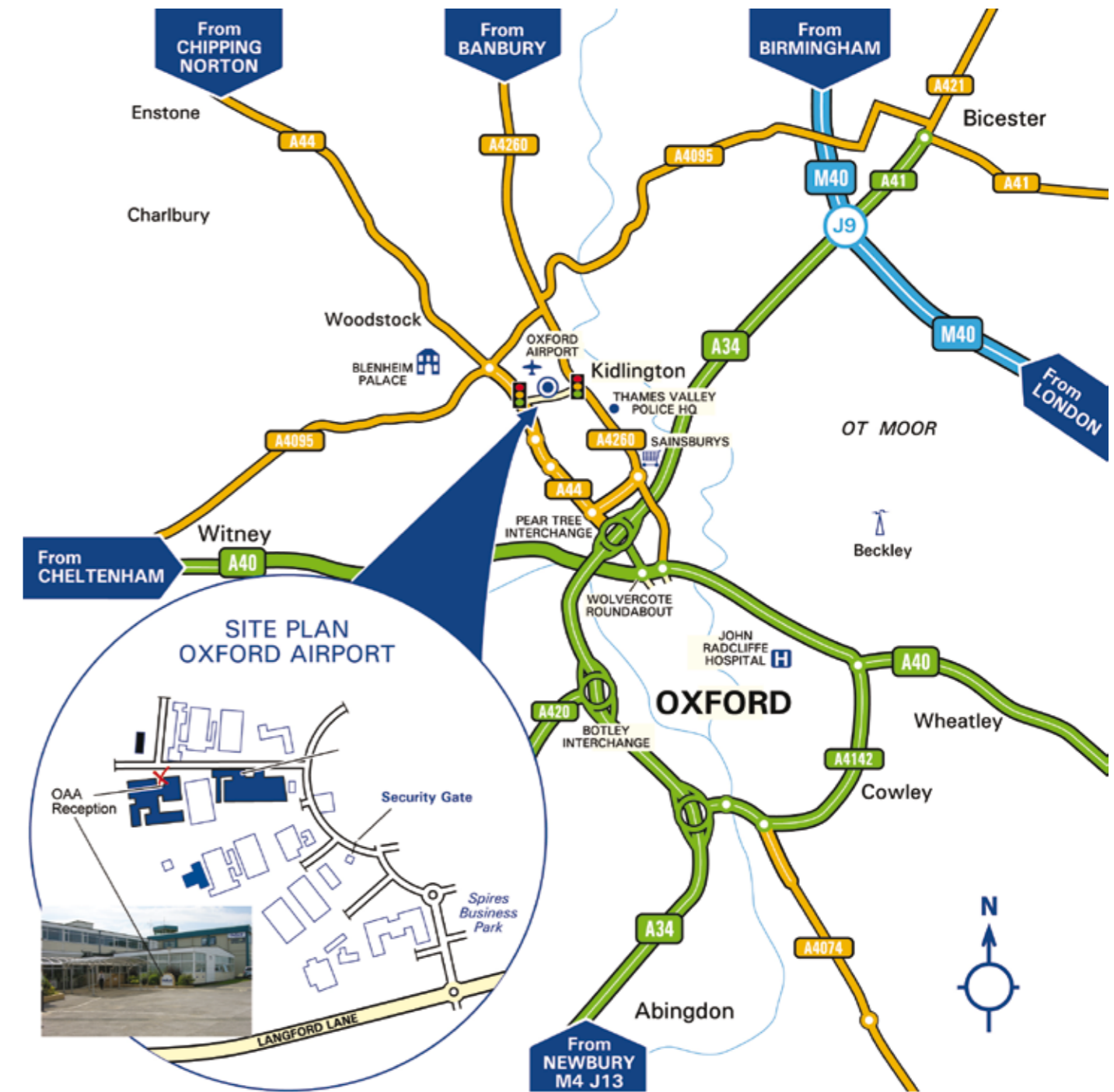
by taxi
